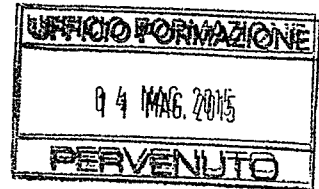

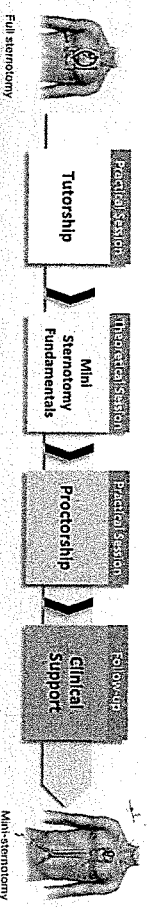
MINIMALLY INVASIVE AVR SURGERY (MIAVR) * EDUCATIONAL CURRICULUM

The learning curve is a reality in Minimally Invasive Surgery (MIS). MIS requires different skills than those used for full sternotomy. Moreover, a team approach is needed to achieve optimal clinical outcomes, and is essential for the long-term success of the MIS program.

For this reason, Edwards Professional Education has designed a specific MIAVR Educational Pathway. The goal of the curriculum is to manage the learning curve of the full MIS team. A step-by-step approach has been defined to increase MIS team expertise during the learning phase.

The MIAVR Educational Curriculum is a structured training pathway that includes:

- Well-defined steps, including theoretical, tutorship and proctorship sessions
- Step-by-step progression to prepare the team for different phases in the learning process
- Focus sessions for staying on track
- Training from renowned leaders in MIAVR
- Strategy to facilitate fast track recovery

The course is specifically designed for aortic teams: cardiac surgeons, anesthetists, cardiologists and scrub nurses, who are committed to rapid deployment aortic valve technology. These teams are willing to move from full-sternotomy to mini-sternotomy, and want to know more about upper hemisternotomy surgical techniques and treatment strategies. To get the most from the course, we strongly recommend that the entire team attends.

DESCRIPTION

The two-day program consists of lectures, recorded cases, discussions, with a particular focus on hands-on experience and workshops on rapid deployment valves in a mini-sternotomy environment. Attendance is limited to 40 participants in order to provide each participant the opportunity to interact with the faculty. Participants in this program will have the chance to:

- Get a clear view on MIAVR benefits
- Debate why and when it is best to use a rapid deployment valve
- Share viewpoints on patient management from pre-op, per-op to post-op in an MIAVR environment
- Discuss surgical strategies and choice of surgical approach with recorded cases
- Practice with experts during workshop sessions
- Allow free interaction with the faculty

Chris Young, M.D.

Chris Young is a heart surgeon at St Thomas' Hospital in London with expertise in coronary bypass surgery, aortic heart valve replacement, aortic aneurysm surgery, and MIS heart surgery. Chris qualified in 1980 from Sheffield University Medical School and within four years had passed all his general surgical fellowship exams. From here he embarked on a career in cardiothoracic surgery with early training at London's St Bartholomew's and St Thomas' hospitals, he spent two years on heart surgery research at the Rayne Institute as a British Heart Foundation Junior Research Fellow. This led to a doctorate in medicine in 1991. He finished his training with a year as senior registrar at Great Ormond St Hospital for Sick Children (GOS) then 12 months at the Queen Elizabeth Hospital in Birmingham (QE) where he developed his passion for aortic vascular surgery and the aortic valve. At both GOS and the QE Hospitals, he was heavily involved in setting up heart transplant programs.

Having decided to concentrate on the cardiac and vascular elements of the specialty, Chris went on to super-specialist training in all aspects aortic valve and aortic aneurysm work including MIS heart surgery, complicated aneurysm surgery, redo surgery.

Chris has been at the forefront of TAVI development and has been a European proctor for the Edwards SAPIEN devices. He is PI for the pan-European Foundation study on rapid deployment aortic valve replacement. He trains and proctors widely in MIS aortic valve surgery and rapid deployment aortic valve replacement technology.
